

The Commission on Veterans Patriotic Events invites you to participate in the oldest and largest July 4th Parade on Long Island, which will take place on **Monday, July 4th** at 10:00 a.m. Your entry must comply and be appropriate with a **Patriotic/Celebratory theme**. Please arrive at the Railroad Plaza no later than 8:00 a.m.

All floats must enter on Elm Street from Hampton Road, which is opposite Southampton Town Hall, left onto Layton Ave., right onto Maple Street, to the Railroad Plaza. All cars are to park in Our Lady of Poland Church parking lot.

Insurance coverage requires that all entries follow these restrictions for parade participants in the Village of Southampton. For the safety of the spectators, and to prevent them from going into the street, there will be:

1. NO throwing of candy, money, or any other objects along the parade route.
2. NO handing out pamphlets, flags, or any other material.
3. NO excessive delays or noise during the parade route.
4. All entries remain in the line of march along entire parade route.

**ANYONE NOT COMPLYING WITH THESE RULES  
WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE LINE OF MARCH**

The application fee for all commercial entries is \$250.00, or whatever you would like to contribute. Donations in any amount are greatly appreciated and 100% of all donations helps defray the cost of the parade. Please mail checks payable to the Commission on Veterans Patriotic Events and mail to the address above, along with your application. All other entries are not required to pay this fee unless they choose to do so as a contribution.
