

Southamptonfest Returns for Its 13th Year

A Weekend Celebration of Local Life, Community, and Culture

SOUTHAMPTON, NY – August 15, 2025 — The Village of Southampton is proud to announce the return of Southamptonfest, now in its 13th year, taking place the weekend of October 3–5, 2025. This beloved tradition brings together residents and visitors for a lively, family-friendly weekend celebrating all that makes Southampton Village so special — especially in the Fall season.

Festivities kick off Friday evening, October 3, with the annual Rotary Club Party at the Southampton Cultural Center—a high-spirited evening of music, dancing and community connection. Hosted by the Southampton Rotary Club, the event supports the club’s long-standing mission of service and goodwill throughout the Village.

The main event unfolds on Saturday, October 4, with a full day of art, design, culture and family fun throughout the Village. Highlights include the fan-favorite Chowder Contest, sheep shearing demonstrations and petting zoo, a village-wide Art & Design Walk, sidewalk sales from local merchants, live music in Agawam Park and seasonal food offerings from beloved local restaurants. It’s a celebration of the season and the local businesses and institutions that give Southampton its unique charm.

This year, like last year, a portion of the proceeds from Southamptonfest will support the restoration of the Village’s World War I Memorial in Agawam Park, a historic and meaningful landmark dating back to 1923.

A host of beloved local institutions will be participating in the celebration, including: Peter Marino Art Foundation, Southampton Cultural Center, Southampton Arts Center, Rogers Memorial Library, Southampton History Museum, Southampton African American Museum, Southampton Chamber of Commerce and more. Also joining the festivities are the Southampton Village Fire Department, Southampton Village Volunteer Ambulance Corps, Heart of the Hamptons, Hampton Flea & Vintage, North Sea Maritime Center, the Southampton Animal Shelter Foundation and many more.

These organizations and many others will be offering festive programming, exhibitions, shopping, and more throughout the weekend.
